Summary of Essential Job Functions

- Install Coaxial Cables, Copper/Fiber Cables, Dress, Terminate and Test
- Install Racks, Ladders Racks and Cable Trays
- Install Equipment/Antennas

Location

- Dallas, TX and Atlanta, GA (MUST be available for multi-overnight travel)

Skills & Knowledge

- Use of basic hand tools and equipment.
- Installation of coaxial or fiber cabling, mounting supports and dressing of the cabling.
- Knowledge of setting up and programming RF and Fiber Test Equipment, Wall Penetrations/Floor Cores and Fire Stop.
- Installation of telecommunication equipment, racks, cabinets, cable ladder and misc. equipment, including transmission equipment, power, alarms, punch-down and dressing/labeling of components.
- Previous working and/or hold certificates for operating scissor or boom-lift equipment.
- Understanding and use of established safety requirements and procedures and/or hold OSHA 10 or 30 certifications.

Abilities Required

- Capable of physically bending, reaching and lifting up to 50 lbs.
- Only candidates eligible to work in the United States and are presently Dallas, TX or Atlanta, GA residents need apply.
- Must possess a valid Driver's License and pass a background and MVR (driving record) check, drug test and pre-employment screening.
